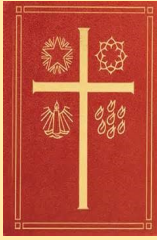

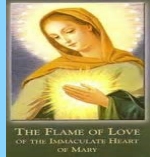

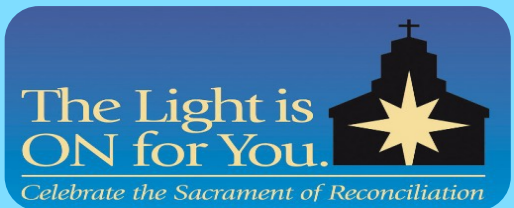

MARIAN MOVEMENT OF PRIESTS PRAYER CENACLE AT QUEEN OF PEACE PARISH. We meet every Sunday evening in church at 7pm. We start with a hymn 'Come Holy Ghost, then the Rosary. After the rosary, a reading from Fr. Gobbi's Blue book of Marian Messages (has an imprimatur by Bishop +Donald W. Montrose, D.D.), with a short reflection by a priest or deacon present, then we recite the Consecration to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. 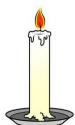

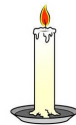
