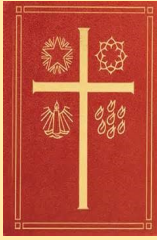

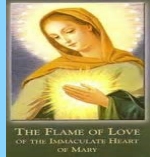

The priests will anoint those who can benefit from this sacrament

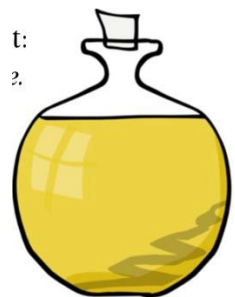
- ~ *Someone whose health is seriously impaired by sickness or old age.*
